

1. Live for God and His eternal purposes.

2. Pray (talk to God) and read the Bible daily.

4. Be baptized.

(Acts 2:38)*

5. Trust God who has the power to change things.

"Put your life in the hands of the Lord; have faith in Him..." (Psalm 37:5)

6. Resist any urges to turn away from God.

"... letting go those things which are past, and stretching out to the things which are before, go forward to the rudder, even the rudder of the ship, the purpose of God in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 3:13-14)

7. Tell others.

*"Go into all the world, and preach the Good News to the whole creation."
(Mark 16:15)*
